Starting Friday, March 4, Tribal Council no longer will require masks to be worn on the Reservation, except in certain areas. These areas will be clearly marked by signs. Places continuing to require masks be worn include, but not limited to, the health and dental clinic.

Why Future COVID Variants Remain A Concern?

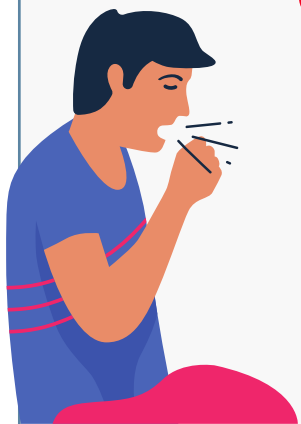

Moderna, Pfizer, and Pfizer Pediatric vaccines provided.

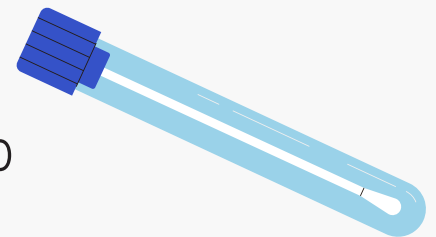
