If You Test Positive For COVID, Isolate From Others

Even if you are vaccinated, if you test positive for COVID-19, please isolate from others:

- Stay home for 5 days
- If you have no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you may leave your home
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you have a fever, stay home until it resolves.

If You're Exposed To A COVID-Positive Person, When Should You Quarantine?

If you have been boosted, or completed primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within last 6 months, or completed primary series of J&J vaccine within last 2 months:

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days
- Test on day 5 if possible
- If you develop symptoms, get tested and stay home.



If you're unvaccinated, or completed primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted, or completed primary series of J&J vaccine over 2 months ago and are not boosted:

- Stay home for 5 days. After that, continue wearing a mask around others for another 5 days
- If you cannot quarantine, you must wear a mask for 10 days
- Test on day 5 if possible
- If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.
