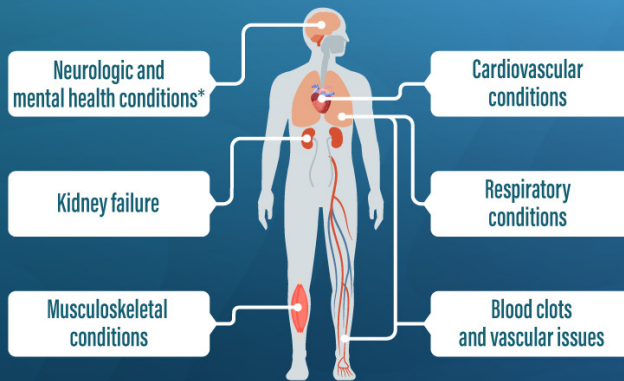

What To Know About Long-COVID Symptoms

People with post-COVID (or long-COVID) conditions can have a wide range of symptoms that can last more than four weeks or even months after infection. Sometimes the symptoms go away and come back.

Post-COVID conditions may not affect everyone the same way. People with post-COVID conditions may experience health problems from different types and combinations of symptoms happening over different lengths of time. Most patients' symptoms slowly improve.
