COVID Summer Travel Safety Tips

Summer travel presents greater opportunity to spread COVID. Even though the CDC no longer requires masks on public transportation, it continues to recommend people wear masks in indoor public transportation settings. If you plan to travel this summer, please consider the following tips as you prepare to enjoy summer vacation:

- ✓ Ensure your COVID-19 vaccines are up to date before travel.
- ✓ Check your destination's COVID-19 situation before traveling. State, tribal, local, and territorial governments may have travel restrictions in place.
- ✓ Wearing a mask over your nose and mouth is recommended in indoor areas of public transportation (including airplanes) and indoors in U.S. transportation hubs (including airports).
- ✓ Do not travel if you have COVID-19 symptoms, tested positive for COVID-19, are waiting for results of a COVID-19 test, or had close contact with a person with COVID-19 and are recommended to quarantine.

What Mask Type Most Protects Against COVID-19

- ★ Loosely woven cloth masks provide least protection
- ★ Layered finely woven masks offer more protection
- ★ Surgical masks & KN95s offer even more protection
- ★ NIOSH respirators (including N95s) protect most
